


## KAT-A6084 LS9 head stud kit

Torque sequence and spec



- 1. Wash all studs and nuts with mineral spirits or brake cleaner
- 2. Install studs in the block using blue Loctite (242)
- 3. Make sure the stud has bottomed out. You will feel resistance when the stud is bottomed out.
- 4. Torque stud in the block to 25 ft-lbs.
- 5. Liberally apply CMD Extreme Pressure Lube #3 to both sides of the washer, on the threads of the stud, and the nut.
- 6. Follow the torque sequence above
- 7. First pass torque the large nuts (1-10 above) to 50 ft-lbs
- 8. Second pass torque the large nuts (1-10 above) to 80 ft-lbs
- 9. Torque the pinch nuts (11-15 above) to 20 ft-lbs
